THANKSGIVING GLASSES

Print the template on card stock and have the children color the pieces. Attach the bows to the frame by fitting them into the designated slots.

HANDS AND FOOT TURKEY

Trace each child's foot on brown or tan construction paper. Trace the child's hands on several different colors of construction paper. Cut out foot and hands. Have the child glue the hands behind the heel of their cut out foot (for feathers). Have the children cut out and glue on the eyes, gobbler, and beak.
